MACBA presents *Melanie Smith: Farce and Artifice*, the most comprehensive exhibition of the artist's work in Europe to date, encompassing Smith's assemblages, paintings, videos, photography and installations.

Smith (1965, UK) moved to Mexico City in 1989, becoming a protagonist within the Mexican art scene of the 1990s. She has addressed interrelated themes in her work from the effects and detritus of industrialisation, the economies and aesthetics of abstraction, and urbanisation, colonialism, nature and entropy.

The exhibition includes key works such as *Spiral City* (2002), *Xilitla* (2010), *Fordlandia* (2014) and *Bucolic Obscurities* (2017), and will present the world premiere of a new film, *María Elena* (2018).
